Osborne Academy Trust STEM Challenge Competition


As you may be aware, there is currently an exciting Osborne STEM challenge taking place across all the schools in the Osborne Co-operative Academy Trust. STEM is the acronym for a focus on science, technology, engineering and mathematics subjects.

This competition, open to all pupils from EYFS to KS5, aims to promote environmental awareness and responsible use of natural resources. Students have been encouraged to participate by creating projects that address issues such as climate change, water and electricity conservation, and animal welfare. Pupils can be as creative as they like and cover anything else related to the environment.

Here are some ideas of the types of things your child could do:

- Design posters highlighting the importance of reducing plastic waste,
- Create short films on how to save water at home
- Write poems advocating for wildlife protection.




