The collection trolley and display are located in the main school office area.



Year 1 Year 1 have been exploring related facts to 7 in maths this week.

In Art in year 4 we have been looking at warm and cool colours. Aboriginal art uses warmer earthy colours such as chocolate browns, oranges and deep reds as well as yellows and creams. We have used the 'Dreamscape ' technique to create our own pictures.



#### Year 5

In Year 5, we have been learning to use and apply column addition to add several 5 - and 6-digit numbers. We used place value counters to develop our conceptual understanding of addition. We then applied this knowledge by using an efficient written method. We have really enjoyed our Maths lessons this week.



#### Year 6

This week in literacy, Year 6 took a step back in time to explore the Silent Movie era. In preparation for their next unit, they acted out different scenarios without speaking, while their classmates had to guess what was happening. ### Foot Steps 1H


In Footsteps 1H, we worked together to build a den using the creative structure Miss Chaplin bought us.
