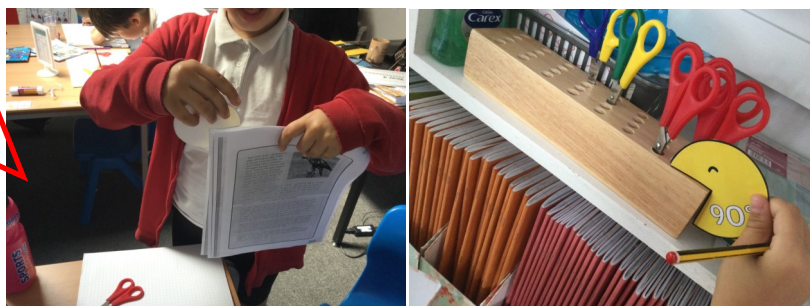
Year 3

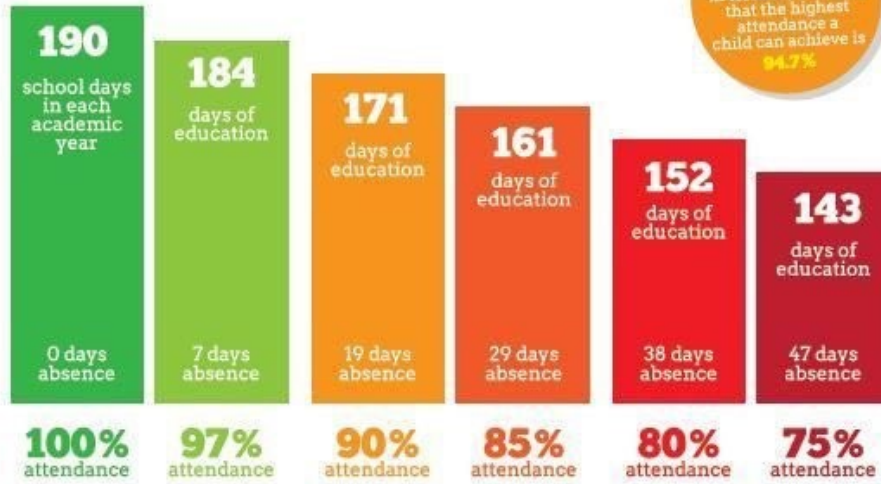
