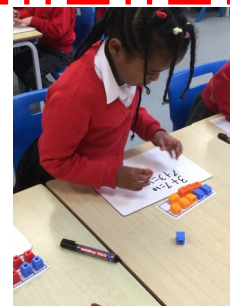

Year 1

The children have been representing addition up to 10. The children were able to use a tens frame to do this and form their number sentence.



Year 6

This week, the children have been exploring fractions in maths lessons. We looked at equivalence, simplifying, adding and subtracting them in a variety of different ways.



Nursery

In Year 2, we have been going 'Above and Beyond' this week, by creating animal habitats and significant people models for our creative homework projects.



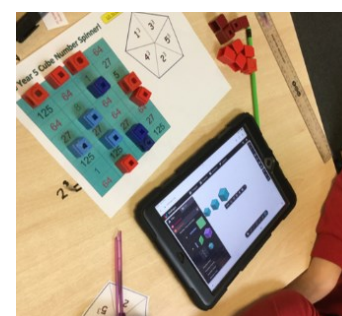
Year 4

In year 4 we started a new topic in science... Sound! We enjoyed moving around classrooms to take part in various sound experiments. We explored how vibrations are created, how we can change the pitch and volume of instruments, as well as exploring our outside environment for different sounds. As you can imagine, things got very, very noisy!!



Year 5

As part of our learning in maths in Year 5, we developed our conceptual knowledge about cubed numbers using multi-link. We also used the link <https://mathigon.org/polypad> mathigon polypad to visually build cubed numbers. We applied our fluency knowledge by playing a mathematical game which required us to calculate cube numbers.



Reception

Reception have been learning about Remembrance Day and have made our own poppies to show our respect.

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
